## Cisco to set up India manufacturing unit; Cisco chief meets PM Modi

US technology major Cisco announced today that it will begin manufacturing in Tamil Nadu as part of efforts to diversify its global supply chain by setting a target of \$1 billion in combined domestic production and exports in the coming years. Cisco CEO Chuck Robbins met Prime Minister Narendra Modi today.

The Cisco chief said in a tweet that his company is investing in manufacturing in India, with an aim to drive over \$1 billion in combined domestic production and exports. "Thank you for your leadership, Honorable PM of India, @narendramodi! "Thrilled to announce @Cisco is investing in manufacturing in India, with an aim to drive over \$1B in combined domestic production & exports." A statement from the company said. "This move is a part of Cisco's strategy to create an even more diverse and resilient global supply chain and support India's vision of becoming a global manufacturing hub. "With this latest investment, Cisco will cater to the growing



demand from customers in India and aims to drive more than \$1 billion in combined domestic production and exports in the coming years. "The creation of a new manufacturing operation was announced by Cisco Chair and CEO Chuck Robbins in New Delhi, following a meeting with Prime Minister Narendra Modi, and a series of strategic engagements with Dr.S. Jaishankar, External Affairs Minister, Rajeev Chandrasekhar, Union Minister of State for

Entrepreneurship, Skill Development, Electronics & Technology, B.V.R. Subrahmanyam, CEO of NITI Aayog, and K. Rajaraman, Telecom Secretary. "Today, we are announcing strategic investments in Indian manufacturing capabilities as the next step in delivering cutting-edge technologies to our customers in India and across the globe," said Chuck Robbins, chair and CEO of Cisco. "Fueled by a rapidly developing digital

economy, India is a focal point of innovation and business for Cisco, and we remain deeply committed to our partnerships here." The manufacturing facility will build Cisco's best-in-class technology, designed to provide flexible, cost-effective delivery of next-generation services and applications and support complex cloud computing environments. The products can meet companies' dynamic demands as they strive to foster agility in an increasingly hybrid, digi-

tal-first world.Cisco is now building core manufacturing capabilities in India, including testing, development and logistics, and expanding in-house repair operations. In addition to supporting supply chain resiliency, reducing lead times, and elevating customer experience, this will add further impetus to the local economy.

India is a key market for Cisco and its second largest R&D center outside the US. Since commencing operations in India in 1995, Cisco has focused on helping the country digitize at scale and speed, including accelerating the transformation of critical sectors like transport, agriculture, including through the Country Digitization Acceleration program, and building a skilled workforce through the Cisco Networking Academy program, it said.

## My priority to provide best cancer care treatment in Himachal : CM Sukhu

Chief Minister, Thakur Sukhvinder Singh Sukhu held a meeting with prominent oncologist of the country, Dr G K Rath, Professor Emeritus Department of Radiation and Oncology and Head of the National Cancer Institute, (NCI), AIIMS at New Delhi today.

Since cancer cases are increasing at an alarming rate in Himachal Pradesh with growth rate of 2.2 percent as against 0.6 percent in the country besides North India registering the highest number of cases, detailed discussions were held regarding strengthening cancer treatment facilities and overall health infrastructure in the state. Chief Minister disclosed that about 8500 cases were detected every year on an average and many go unnoticed and undetected in the remotest belts of the State.

"It is my priority to provide best health facilities in every far reaching corner of the state and this is the main focus area of my Government," said the Chief Minister. The State

Government is also exploring the possibility of setting up a centrally funded National Cancer Institute at Hamirpur, said Sh. Sukhu.

He stressed upon creating awareness amongst the masses about the fatal disease and urged holding cancer awareness programmes and organizing workshops in collaboration with the NCI.

He also underlined the need for more screening and detection so that proper treatment could be provided at an early stage of cancer.

Besides, discussions were also held about the possibility of starting a pilot project for health vaccination of adolescent girls in this regard for a healthy future population.

Dr. Rath apprised the Chief Minister that 50 percent of cancer is curable and also briefed about latest cancer treatment technology. Vivek Bhatia, Principal Private Secretary to the Chief Minister and Col K S Bashtu OSD to Chief Minister were also present in the meeting.

### BRIEF NEWS

#### SC to pronounce judgement on Maha political crisis Thursday

**NEW DELHI,AGENCY :** The Supreme Court will pronounce on Thursday its judgement on political crisis in Maharashtra over the rebellion by Shiv Sena leader Eknath Shinde and other MLAs, leading to fall of Maha Vikas Aghadi government led by Uddhav Thackeray. An announcement in this regard was made by Chief Justice of India D Y Chandrachud during the hearing on pleas related to legal sanction to same sex marriage. A five-judge Constitution bench of CJI Chandrachud and Justices M R Shah, Krishna Murari, Hima Kohli and P S Narasimha had on March 16 reserved its judgements on a batch of petitions filed by both the sides.

#### 91.87 pc turnout in Meghalaya assembly bypoll

**SHILLONG,AGENCY :** Over 91 per cent of the electorate cast their votes for the adjourned Sohiong assembly byelection in Meghalaya till 5 pm on Wednesday, election officials. Chief Electoral Officer Frederick Roy Kharkongor till 5 pm the total number of voters who cast their ballot was 91.87 per cent and the voting percentage is expected to go higher. Election to 23-Sohiong (ST) assembly seat, which is one of the 55 out of the total 60 reserved for the Scheduled Tribe in the Meghalaya legislative assembly, was adjourned just before the February 27 assembly elections due to the death on February 20 of one of the candidates Horju Donkupar Roy Lyngdoh, a former minister and candidate of the United Democratic Party (UDP). Sohiong constituency in East Khasi Hills has over 34, 000 registered voters out of which 17000 are female and 16000 are male voters. Polling started on a brisk note and by 9 am 26 per cent of the voters cast their ballot. The numbers kept on rising and by 3 pm the voting percentage touched 87.39 per cent. The main contest in the constituency is between Samlin Malngiang of the ruling National People's Party, Synshar Lyngdoh Thabab from UDP and S Osborne Kharjana of Congress.

#### 'The Kerala Story' team meets UP CM Yogi

Taking to micro-blogging site Twitter, the CM wrote in Hindi, "The Kerala Story will be made tax-free in Uttar Pradesh." After this the CM Office tweeted, "CM Yogi, along with his entire cabinet, will watch the film 'The Kerala Story' in Lucknow on May 12."

## Preparations for national games almost complete : CM Sawant

## J&K starts luxury bus to Teetwal close to LoC to boost tourism
